SETTING UP AN APPOINTMENT

How do I make an appointment? Where do I go?



- *Access to a computer or mobile device*
- The CDC has created a set of "phases": different groups of people that are **eligible** for their vaccine at different times. You can visit this [page](#) to determine which phase you fit into.
- If you are currently eligible, this [link](#) will take you to the Washtenaw County Health Department where you can click on the button that says "Request a vaccine from WCHD"

PREPARING FOR THE APPOINTMENT

What do I need to bring with me?



- You will need a form of identification
- Wear a mask if you have one, if you don't one will be provided for you
- Don't go to your appointment if you are feeling sick

DURING THE APPOINTMENT

What is going to happen at the appointment?



- You will likely wait in a line and have your ID confirmed
- You will fill out a checklist making sure that you are not experiencing any COVID **symptoms**
- The person giving you the shot might be a nurse, public health worker, or member of the national guard (they will be in uniform)
- After receiving the shot, you will wait in a separate room for about 15 minutes to make sure you don't have a bad **reaction**
- You will likely set up the appointment for your second vaccination at this time

AFTER THE APPOINTMENT

What are the effects of the vaccine? Is there anything I need to do after leaving?



- Some people experience **milder** versions of COVID symptoms, but that does not mean you are sick!
- Write down your date for the 2nd appointment, and don't forget to go
- Continue to wear a mask in public spaces
