Summarize and respond to major ideas and evidence presented in spoken messages.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Discuss with a classmate something heard in a presentation. 			
Go beyond the information given by a speaker, making inferences, and drawing appropriate conclusions.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Make decisions based on information heard, such as: buying a car. Analyze political commentaries.
