



HOW TO VOTE IN PERSON

IN MICHIGAN, THERE ARE
TWO WAYS:

1. *Vote at your County Clerk with an absentee ballot*
2. *Vote on Election Day at a polling place*



HOW TO VOTE IN PERSON AT YOUR COUNTY CLERK WITH AN ABSENTEE BALLOT:

1. [Click here](#) to make sure you are registered to vote.
2. On the same website as step 1, search for your County Clerk's office.
3. **Between September 29 and November 8, go to your County Clerk's office.**
4. At the County Clerk's office, fill out the absentee ballot paperwork.
5. The Clerk will give you an absentee ballot so you can vote in the office.

HOW TO VOTE IN PERSON ON ELECTION DAY AT A POLLING PLACE:

1. [Click here](#) to make sure you are registered to vote.
2. On the same website as step 1, search for your closest polling location.
3. On **November 8th**, go to the polling location and vote.
The polls are open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m., but you'll still be allowed to vote if you are in line by 8 p.m.
