

## Washtenaw Literacy COVID Guidelines

These guidelines are for health and safety. They are to protect our staff, volunteers, and learners. These guidelines may change. We follow information from the Washtenaw County Health Department and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

### What You Should Expect

- We will do everything we can to keep learners, tutors, and staff healthy and safe.
- Your temperature will be taken when you arrive. You must be within the normal range (97-99 degrees) to attend tutoring. If you have a temperature, you will be asked to leave and not return for 10 days.
- We will have information on testing and vaccinations.
- We may ask you to help with cleaning your area at the end of your tutoring session.
- We will give you clear information if there is a change in our schedule or plans.
- Wash, Wipe, Cover - Don't Infect Another! We will give you information on hand washing, covering coughs, and social distancing.

### What We Expect

- **You must be fully vaccinated and current on boosters for in-person tutoring.**
- **Stay home if you are feeling sick**, for example: ✓ Fever ✓ Cough ✓ Sore throat ✓ Runny or stuffy nose ✓ Body aches ✓ Headache ✓ Chills ✓ Tiredness
  - If you are feeling sick, get a rapid at-home test or take a PCR test. Ask staff if you need more information.
- **Stay masked indoors. Your mask must cover your mouth and nose. You must use the mask we give you.**
- **If you have COVID or have been near someone with COVID, tell us immediately.**
- Use the hand sanitizer, tissues, and trash cans.
- Ask staff where you can wash up or disinfect your hands.
- Try not to share items like pens, books, etc.
- Keep 6 feet away from other groups/pairs.
- Vaccines are safe and effective. If you want information about vaccines or boosters, ask staff.
