

Lesson Planning Suggestions for Reading/Writing Advanced

Consider these general suggestions and reminders for lesson planning as well as the following pages specific to word study, reading and writing.

Who's Got GAME? <i>CP p.40</i>	Rules of Thumb/Keys
Goal Activity Materials Evaluation	80/20 Rule: Aim for 80% comfort/20% stretch during lesson. 100% Rule: Design homework for 100% learner success. Encourage Self Determination. <i>CP pp.10-11</i> Use Explicit Instruction whenever appropriate. <i>CP p.19</i>

Monitor Progress <i>CP p.44</i>	
Constantly assess learner and use evaluation to inform lesson planning. <i>RR p.5</i> Keep logs of books read, words learned, writing samples.	
Keep In Touch	Have Fun
Call/e-mail staff. Contact mentor.	Keep talking about learner's priorities and what is working best.

Skills to Work On
Irregular vowel sounds. Reading and writing most compound words and contractions. Reading and spelling words from the Intermediate and Advanced word family lists. Using the 100 Most Frequent Words in English in everyday writing. Reading longer, more complicated material with comprehension. Using legible penmanship to complete everyday writing tasks. Recognizing and using complex prefixes and endings: un-, dis-, pre-, -er, -est, -ly. Advanced guided writing exercises. Recognizing and using common contractions.
